Summer Assignment

Part 1

1. Examine the Table of Contents:
 - a. Name the Units that it is divided into.
 - b. What is the "format" of the APES exam?
 - c. What percent of the test will be taken from each section?
 - d. Name the topics that make up 20% or more of the test.
 - e. Name the topics that cover 10% or more of the exam.
2. Briefly explain the first 4 Questions from "Questions Commonly Asked About the APES Exam?".
3. Describe the "Plus – Minus" system.
4. List the types of multiple choice questions.
5. List the three types of free-response questions.
6. List five examples of "Key Terms" used in the free-response essays.
7. List five tips for answering free-response questions.

Part 2

1. For **each** of the eleven chapters complete the following:
 - a. Write the name of the chapter.
 - b. List three areas that you will be tested on.
 - c. List and define five terms that are unfamiliar to you.
 - d. List **all** the “key concepts” (headings in **BOLD, ALL CAPS**) found in the chapter i.e., **GEOLOGIC TIME SCALE, EARTH STRUCTURE, PLATE TECTONICS**.
 - e. Chose **one** of the key concepts and outline the topics of that concept.
 - f. Study **all** figures in the chapter and list the titles of each.

2. Multiple-choice questions. For each chapter:
 - a. Answer any 5 questions. Write the question and your selected answer.
 - b. Classify the type of question (from Part 1 #4).
 - c. Check your answer.
 - d. Read the explanation for each answer. Were you correct? Explain.

3. Free-response questions. For each chapter:
 - a. Read the free response question
 - b. Explain what type of free response question this is (from page xiii - xv)
